Sub-Committee on Case Studies Women's Ecumenical Liaison Group

Geneva, 28 January, 1970

The Committee first drew up a list of 12 countries representing different degrees of ecumenical consciousness. The names and addresses of individuals in these countries, from whom case-studies might be solicited, will be obtained through consultation with other members of the Liaison Group.

"Guide-lines" to assist the person recounting the particular ecumenical experience were then drawn up. Miss Meersman will check these as to form with a sociologist; They ment will be sent for the two chairmen and secretaries for approval and then will be mailed out to the total Liaison Group.

Case-studies will be sent to either Miss Meersman or Mrs. Strong directly. When sufficient number have been received, the Sub-Committee will meet again, to put them together into a Study document with questions to stimulate discussion.
