Lisbon censure threat

DR FRANCISCO sa Carneiro, leader of Portugal's conserva-tive Social Democratic Party, said yesterday that his party will strongly oppose the new Government of Miss Maria de Lourdes Pintassilgo. "Boycott is too weak a word," he said.

Dr Sa Carneiro said that the Social Democrats will probably move a censure motion against the interim Government when it presents its programme to Parliament next week. He said the new Government was under the influence of the "Group of Nine," an alliance of military officers close to the President who unseated Portugal's sixth revolutionary Government in a preemptive military action on November 1, 1975. The Group of Nine later backed General Eanes for the Presi-

dency.

"This preclection Government has been formed
against the Social Democratic
Party, giving the Socialists,
Communists and Independent Party, giving the Socialists, Communists and Independent focial Deports an unfair UTO Carneiro added. "Three dissidents from my party are represented in the Cabinet, and we also object to the political personality of the Prime Minister."

He said his party was confident of success in the elections, which should be held in November.

The Social Democrats recently formed an electoral alliance with two other conalliance with two other con-servative parties, in the hope of consolidating the Right-wing vote. The Social Demo-cratic leader said his party would probably decide would probably decide against a joint electoral ticket with the Centre Social Democrats and the Popular Monarchist Party, partners in the alliance. He said that, among other factors, the party would lose television and radio time if they opted for a joint ticket.

The Social Democrat censure motion is unlikely to be successful, even with the support of the Centre Democrats. It is not yet known whether the Socialist Party will support the Government's programme or abstain: if they abstain, the new Government could be in
