Dear colleagues,

The European Foundation has no means to do this necessary important job. We would thus be very grateful if colleagues from these countries could deliver us these translations.

We shall send a copy of this letter to the other participants of the invitation-conference and to our scientific relations in Europe. If they can assist the European Foundation in one way or another to stimulate the dialogue on social quality to develop and to sustain authentic bench marks for new social policies, this assistance will be very welcome.
