NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. The President of the Security Council wishes to refer to resolution 446 (1979), adopted by the Security Council at its 2134th meeting on 22 March 1979 in connexion with the situation in the occupied Arab territories.
2. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Security Council decided to establish a Commission, consisting of three members of the Security Council, to be appointed by the President of the Council after consultation with the members of the Council, to examine the situation relating to settlements in the Arab territories occupied since 1967, including Jerusalem.
3. In accordance with that decision, the President wishes to report that he has had consultations with the members of the Council and that agreement has been reached that the Commission will be composed of the following three members of the Council: Bolivia, Portugal and Zambia.
