Released here last week, most of the 10,000 copies of the book were sold the same day, so that police were only able to confiscate a few hundred, and some canny shopkeepers retrieved copies for illicit sale.

He later recruits "Marito" (Socialist leader Mario Soares) to his team, but they fall out and Eanito is forced to sack him. He then elevates Pintasilgo (Prime Minister Maria de Lourdes Pintassilgo) to assist in the bullring, but disaster befalls after she reveals her "pacote" - a double entendre which refers, on the one hand, to wages and prices packets presented by governments, but also means backside. The Prime Minister is shown baring her backside to a horrified crowd, as Socialist Prime Minister Mario Soares had earlier displayed his "pacote." The team disintegrates soon afterwards, and the torreador Eanito is dunked in the Tagus river by an irate citizenry.
