

Industrialist Slain in Portugal

PENAFIEL, Portugal, Aug. 21 (AP) — A Portuguese industrialist charged with taking part in a series of rightist bomb attacks three years ago was machine-gunned to death early today near this northern city.

Joaquim Ferreira Torres, 55, reportedly was ambushed after leaving his summer home for his textile factory in Famalicao. Police there said the victim's sports car was sprayed with bullet holes.

They said the car appeared to have been hit by machine-gun fire from the front, before going off the road and striking a fence, and then from behind.
