a) A window of opportunity :

2 open spaces,

→ one the European space; complexity of its institutions (EC/CSCE/Council of Europe/
WEU---)
• unpredictability of about evolution of its components

→ the other: the social territory of women

- theoretically embracing all sectors,
but in practice a narrow territory
(mainly ~~absent from~~ decision-making, cf. Lisbon Council)

- shift from often focused on W as the receiving end, recipient, objects, victims..

in a context of interdependence
becoming part of a complex system;
 - regulations mechanisms not yet discovered,
hence delays in decision-making;
contradictory gestures (^(Doc.) Germany → Coalitz
^(June) France → Sengiers)
 - (Europe + world integrated
in the Renaissance period
but asymetric to the world + inside its borders
+ centered on elites → change with
communications)

3) individual rights in the context of collective rights

- the need for coupling the two:
the collapse of a collectivist political regime
should not erase the reality of collective
needs, rights + obligations;
- threat of individualism / hedonism /
indifference
- the supreme dignity of each person
in the shaping of the political reality:
- "politics belongs to everyone"

4) citizenship and sovereignty

- anglo-saxon vs. continental*
- citizenship as fulfilment of all rights
 - ~~sovereignty~~ capacity of self-organisation in
an interdependent system
 - new forms + new concepts have to emerge

Management of the economy



1) Status of economy

not a goal but a means

is urgent need to address the ethics

- understanding the limitations of the economic science, so far unable to decide new instruments (e.g. economies in transition)
 \therefore not a dogma! not the criterium to evaluate where is a country, a people ...

2) new regulatory + redistributive mechanisms to compensate for the blinders of the market (situation of Sweden / NL)

3) Market as a logic of internal + external exclusion, built-in inequality, leaving aside the poor/disorganized/vulnerable \therefore another logic

1) From war to peace

- leading the process of transformation from "peace-keeping" to "peace-making"
(in Jan: to create "corridors" 12 Bosnia to avoid confronts....)

 - leading the process of comprehensive banning of nuclear tests
