Dear Recipient of this Bulletin,

I should like to add one preliminary word about the use for which this Documentation Bulletin is intended. As you will see when you examine it more closely, it is not meant to be either definitive or exhaustive, or even a "basic" outline and bibliography. (Therefore do not be alarmed if some familiar basic works are missing.) We shall have to do much more work on the subject together before we can arrive at a satisfactory synthesis.

What it is meant to be is a sort of "working paper" to start the ball of discussion and exchange rolling. Therefore it is not for general distribution, but should be made available primarily to those who in one way or another would like to contribute to our study of woman. These may be members of a Grail research team, or friends who want a serious dialogue with us on the subject of woman, or people competent in one or another specialized field, who may be able to help us on certain particular points.

This bulletin is being sent to all presidents and leaders-in-charge, and in addition to a few other responsible leaders who are already involved in work on the subject of woman. It can also be sent to other interested people on your recommendation, provided the purpose of the bulletin is clearly understood.
