We have been out of communication for some time, but no doubt from mutual friends you have by now heard about our forthcoming WCRP II.

This letter is a cordial invitation for you to be a delegate-- indeed, the only one from Portugal.


Enclosed is the first descriptive brochure of WCRP II, based on the recent meeting of the International Preparatory Committee. I think it may answer most of your questions.

Delegates are asked to arrive at Leuven, outside Brussels, by noon of 27 August and stay until the morning of 4 September. Most delegates will reside in student dormitories or other lodgings. It is expected that the costs of lodging and food for this eight-day period will amount to 4,000 to 6,000 Belgian francs (or the equivalent of \$100 to \$150).

If you can accept this invitation, please let us know as soon as possible. We will, in turn, quickly validate your status as a delegate. We will then send you the background material for delegates to reach you sometime in June as well as detailed travel and other information. If you have any specific questions not covered by this letter or the brochure, please let us know. Address all letters to me reaching New York by May 10th; thereafter to our Leuven address: WCRP II, Maria Theresia College, St. Michaelsstr. 6, 3000 Leuven, Belgium.
