Thank you very much for your letter and for your information. I do sincerely hope that your hard work of getting the essays will soon be finished.

As to your request I would like to add the following details : I graduated as a chemical engineer from the University of Lisbon in 1953, worked for some time in the National Atomic Energy Commission and for six years I was the head of the Documentation Center of a large industrial compound in this country. I am not working professionally now. I have been for four years the National President of the University branch of Catholic Action for women students and I served four years in the Directing Committee of Pax Romana (international movement of catholic students) two of which as International President. It might be interesting for you to know that I was the first woman engineer to work at that industrial concern and that I was until now the only woman to be President of Pax Romana...

The subject of woman in the modern world has been one of my main concerns in the last years and I have written several articles on it. The present essay is therefore the result of personal research. As you know I am a member of the International Grail Movement.

You may handle this information, of which certainly not all is of importance for your purpose at your discretion.

I would like very much to have a good number of reprints. Can you please tell me the conditions to have them ?

I am not quite snre whether I have mentioned to you or not that I would like very much to see the proofs.
