Dear Miss Pintasilgo,

I am indeed sorry to hear that you have been ill. My best wishes for the complete recovery of your strength.

I would really be very grateful if you would give it the highest priority.

All I have heard about the first session of the Council in Rome seems most encouraging. The impression made upon the observers has been very good indeed. I enclose the programme of a course of lectures we are having here which may interest you in showing what we are doing. I think, perhaps, the most encouraging thing in the present situation is the increase in prayer for the unity of all Christians which Christ desires and by the means He wills.
