Dear Rev. Bruce,

It is indeed a "shared impatience" as I was going to write to you again (!) when I got your letter . Thank you very much for it and for all the information about our joint enterprise !

I have important news to give to you which, in a way, will urge us even more . The World Council of Churches and the Secretariat for Unity are holding together a meeting between a group of Roman Catholic Women, including some of the Auditors of the Vatican Council, and a group of women leaders from the constituency of the World Council of Churches . This meeting will take place in Rome, 22nd-25th October . It has a strictly unofficial and informal character, with minimum publicity (So, please, keep this information for yourself) . The main topic of conversation will be "the forms of life and service for women in our respective churches" . Our book should appear before this meeting, don't you think so too ? I have been invited to participate in the meeting, and I would be very happy if this book could be used as reference material for the meeting .

If there is any way in which I could help you, please, let me know . I insist on the point I mention in my last letter to you : it seems to me that the title would gain in being less definite .
