Dear Miss Pintasilgo,

Thank you very much for your letter. I am disappointed that Prof. Groot does not think that he will be able to produce anything. I am in close touch with the Jesuits at Farm Street and I will ask Fr. Corbishley whether he thinks that he or one of his colleagues can produce something on the subject quickly. Prof. Florovsky wrote to me some weeks ago so I have some hopes of getting a paper from him fairly quickly.

I did actually try what you suggest some months ago, but got a negative reply from the publisher. This, however, was not I think a really fair judgment, since I was given to understand that the chairman of the Committee concerned had publicly committed himself to the view that there is no theological objection to the ordination of women!

My daughter is being married in October, and I have a large number of speaking engagements this autumn, many of them arising from the great interest in Teilhard de Chardin which has come about in this country following the publication of some of his books in English.

In a week or two however, I shall hope to get down to a study of the manuscript with a view to offering it to another publisher with or without the missing essays.

My ex-curate, Fr. Roger Greenacre is taking over the Chaplaincy of St. Georges Anglican church in Paris in


September. His address will be;-
